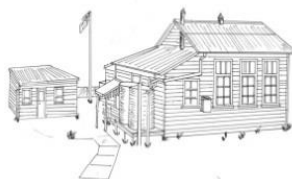

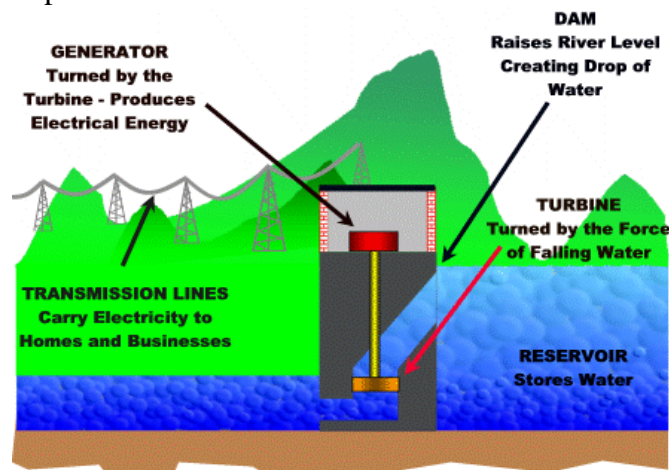
Our Cooma visit is planned for Wednesday 14th Sept.
