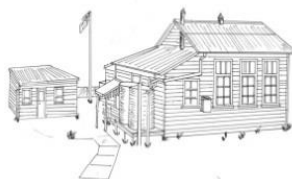

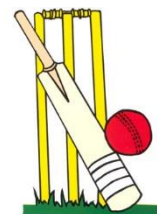
Rivers Swimming Carnival
